Residential & Domestic Sprinklers - One day Seminar

This first of these seminars took place in February 2008 and was oversubscribed so it has been decided to run a similar event in 2009 in Scotland. This reflects the significant interest and application of sprinklers in residential and domestic premises in Scotland. The seminar is intended not only to provide authoritative advice and information from recognized experts in their own areas but also to demonstrate that BAFSA is committed to supporting smaller companies and those entering the industry.

The seminar is intended to assist not only installers but also those responsible for specifying sprinkler protection and enforcers such as building control officials and fire and rescue service officers.

Ample time has been allowed for discussion and questions and it is hoped that this will also enable the different groups attending to exchange views and create an understanding of the different perspectives.
