BAFSA is excited to announce an opportunity to join our Learning Team as an Assessor working with candidates enrolled on the ABBE L2 Certificate in Fire Sprinkler Installation, an assessment programme for experienced sprinkler system installers.

In this role you will support the achievement of candidates with fair and effective assessment of their submitted video evidence in adherence to IQA practices.

A maximum of 10 hours per candidate is allocated for supporting learners with assessment of video evidence as submitted by candidates via BAFSA e-Learning portal including provision of clear constructive feedback, maintaining accurate learners records and upholding QA standards. Liaison with IQA will be required.

Note: A reducing number of hours will apply should candidates not progress or leave without full evidence submissions.

This role is on a self employed basis and is home based.

An hourly rate of £45 is applicable.

Key Responsibilities:

Support learners with assessments and provide clear, constructive feedback
Maintain accurate learner records and uphold quality assurance standards
Liaise with candidates as appropriate to assessor role.
Liaise with IQA.

Strong attention to detail and excellent organisational skills
Ability to work collaboratively and respond positively to change
Interest in fire sprinkler sector

Minimum 2 years' experience providing teaching or instruction
Experience and knowledge of the ABBE L2 Certification in Fire Sprinkler Installation
Holder or willingness to work towards a Level 3 Assessor qualification
